HOMEWORK POLICY

When you have an upcoming test, I will give you a study guide. This should require additional time to review. I typically also send a link to play an optional review game.

FOOD AND DRINK POLICY ABSENCES AND GRADES

Weekly and daily work will be updated weekly on LiveGrades (bell ringers, participation, and quizzes). Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a particular grade.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work (one day for make-up for each day absent). Upon your return, immediately ask for any assignments or information you may have missed.

If you know you are going to be absent beforehand, you should ask me for your make-up work before the absence. This can be done before or after school or via e-mail.

If you miss a test or quiz, it will be given to you immediately upon your return unless there is an activity that conflicts with that.

Additionally, you must be on time for class. If you are tardy, it will be logged on LiveGrades and you may lose the opportunity to complete the bell ringer.
