## Immunization, Physical and Dental Examination Requirements for PreK, Kindergarten, Second, Seventh, and Senior students entering 2021-2022 school year

Dear Parent or Guardian,

West Virginia requirements state that all students in PreK, Kg, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade have proof of a physical exam and a dental exam completed when entering school for the 2021-2022 school year. Additionally, students in PreK, Kg, 7<sup>th</sup>, grade and 12<sup>th</sup> grade have immunization requirements that need to be completed. **These must be provided on the first day of school**.

Physical and Dental exams should:

Be completed within one year of the date of school starting.

Provide at a minimum the date of the dental exam and the dentist signature.

Be signed by the completing provider of the physical, have the date completed, and all information related to a physical exam.

Any further information is always welcomed to assist with follow up care coordination.

If your child is enrolled in Medicaid, CHIP, or any other medical or dental insurance plan, the exam will be paid for by them. If your child needs insurance, please visit WVinRoads at <a href="http://www.wvinroads.org/selfservice/">http://www.wvinroads.org/selfservice/</a> to see if you qualify for Medicaid or CHIP. If you need assistance finding a doctor or dentist, please contact your school nurse.
