

# Graduation 2019 Itinerary

**Wednesday, May 1** – Senior Walk. Seniors will visit their feeder schools to begin the graduation celebrations. **BRING YOUR CAP AND GOWN TO SCHOOL THIS DAY!** We will depart the school at 9am.

**Thursday, May 2** – College Decision Day. Seniors will declare their collegiate or post-secondary intent. Dr. Gunter will address the seniors. Parents are welcome to attend. The ceremony will begin at 1:00pm in the auditorium.

**Wednesday, May 15** – Baccalaureate Ceremony @ 6:30pm in the gymnasium

- Be there by 5:30pm
- Dress Code: Wear your cap, gown, tassel, and cords. It doesn't matter what you wear under it according to Mrs. Endicott, but you still need to look neat and clean.
- If you can't be there, please let Mrs. Katie Endicott know! She will have a Bible for you.

**Thursday, May 16** – Senior Breakfast @ 8:30am in the commons area

- Be there at 8:00am
- Dress Code: Casual dressy, No jeans, Wear dress shoes – **BRING YOUR CAP & GOWN FOR GROUP PICTURE DIRECTLY AFTER BREAKFAST**
- 2 tickets only
- Closed graduation practice directly afterward. School staff and students only.

**Friday, May 17** – Graduation @ 6:30pm in the gymnasium

- Be there by 5:00pm
- Dress Code: Dressy/Formal. It is suggested that girls wear a dress, and boys wear dress slacks and a button up. No jeans or sneakers.
- Wear cap, gown, tassel, and cords. **Don't forget these items!**
- 12 tickets only (4 for downstairs, 8 for upstairs). Children 2 years old or under don't need a ticket. You can share your extra tickets with someone if you won't use all yours.

- If you need help getting any of the required dress code items (example: shoes, dress, tie, shirt, pants, etc.) please let Ms. Gilman know asap!
- Your graduation gown needs to be wrinkle free. If you need someone to iron or steam your gown, please let Ms. Gilman know asap!
- Don't add anything extra to your graduation gown. You may decorate your cap only.
- You will receive your breakfast tickets the week before graduation. You will receive your graduation tickets the day before during senior breakfast/practice.
