### ARMY ROTC SCHOLARSHIPS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

The Four-Year High School Scholarship is for high school students planning on attending a four-year college program. Contact your high school academic advisor or campus Military Science department for more information.

#### Requirements

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be between the ages of 17 and 26
- Have a high school GPA of at least 2.50
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Score a minimum of 1000 on the SAT (math/verbal) or 19 on the ACT (excluding the required writing test scores)
- [Meet physical standards](#)
- Agree to accept a commission and serve in the Army on Active Duty or in a Reserve Component (Army Reserve or Army National Guard)

#### Your Commitment

- An eight-year service commitment with the Army.
- Serve full time in the Army for four years and four years with the Individual Ready Reserve (IRR).

- Selected Cadets may choose to serve part time in the Army Reserve or Army National Guard while pursuing a civilian career

### Apply Online For An Army ROTC Four-Year High School Scholarship

If you are applying for a scholarship, you first will need to create a MY GOARMY account. Once you create an account, you will be sent to the MY GOARMY Log In page. Once you can successfully login to MY GOARMY, you can use your newly created account information to login to the [scholarship application site](#).

To apply for the ROTC Scholarship, an application must be started by 04 February 2019 @ 1159pm EST.

If you have started an application by 04 February 2019, you have until 04 March 2019 @ 1159pm EST to complete your application.

To appear before a Selection Board to be considered for a scholarship, applicants must submit a completed application, including the PMS interview, by 1159pm EST on one of the below "Document Submission Deadlines."

#### Document Submission Deadlines

**1st Board - 14 October 2019** – Document submission deadline. In order for your application to be reviewed by the board, all of the required sections of the application must be complete and documents must be submitted.

**21-25 October 2019** – Board convenes and runs until every packet that was board ready by the start of the board, has been reviewed.

**2nd Board - 6 January 2019** – Document submission deadline. In order for your application to be reviewed by the board, all of the required sections of the application must be complete and documents must be submitted.

**13-17 January 2020** – Board convenes and runs until every packet that was board ready by the start of the board, has been reviewed.

**4 February 2020** – New Application Deadline. The deadline to initiate **NEW** applications for the 2019-2020 School Year is 4 February 2020 @ 1159pm EST. If you have already started your application by this date, you may continue editing your application as necessary in preparation for the board.

**4 March 2020** – Edit Application Deadline. The last chance to edit your application is 4 March 2020 @ 1159pm EST. After this point, your application becomes read-only; meaning, you cannot make any edits to your activities or school choices or major. The only thing you can do with your application at this point, is to upload files.

**3rd Board (FINAL) - 16 March 2020** – Document submission deadline. In order for your application to be reviewed by the board, all of the required sections of the application must be complete and documents must be submitted.

**23-27 March 2020** – Board convenes and runs until every packet that was board ready by the start of the board, has been reviewed.

Scholarship decisions are usually made between two and four weeks following the completion of each board. Continue to check the Selection Status tab of your application to see if you have been selected.

Remember it is **your responsibility**, not your high school counselor, to ensure that your application is complete.

If you change your address or wish to withdraw from competition after submitting your application, please notify us immediately. Be sure to include your full name on your notification.

NOTE: Applicants who were previously boarded but not selected to receive a scholarship, can continue to submit documents to increase their chance for selection.

However, **all application updates must be SUBMITTED no later than 04 March 2019 @ 1159pm EST to be considered for a scholarship during the final board that convenes on 18-22 March 2019.**
