Health Requirements for the 2020-2021 school year

WV state law and rules require that school age children meet certain health requirements before school begins. Please see below for requirements by grade level. Bring all medical forms to the school nurse on the first day of school.

All PreK or Kindergarten students entering school must have a shot record showing all required vaccines have been completed and also a physical exam and a dental exam completed by a healthcare provider before school starts.

All 2nd grade students must have a physical exam and dental exam by a healthcare provider completed before school starts.

All 7th grade students must have a shot record showing proof of having a Tdap and Meningitis vaccine, a physical exam, and a dental exam before school starts.

All 12th grade students must have a shot record showing proof of having a Tdap and Meningitis vaccine, a physical exam, and a dental exam before school starts.

**Any student choosing the virtual option in place of the blended model of learning and wishing to participate in sports programs at the middle school or high school level will still be required to provide proof of vaccine, physical, and dental requirements.

**If students already have a physical exam or a dental exam dated after 09/08/19, this proof of exam may be used.
