#### PROPOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE:

In accordance with 6-9A-4 (3) of School Laws of West Virginia, "The governing body of a public agency may hold an executive session during a regular, special or emergency meeting . . . upon a majority affirmative vote of the members present. To decide upon disciplining, suspension or expulsion of any student in any public school . . . unless the student requests an open meeting."

### a. Expulsion hearing of student A.

Mr. Jewell made the motion to go into executive session. Mr. Goff seconded that motion. The motion was carried with a vote of 5/0. The time was 10:49 a.m.

Mr. Jewell made the motion to return to regular session. Mr. Kominar seconded that motion. The motion passed with a vote of 5/0. The time was 12:14 p.m.

Mr. Kominar made the motion of expulsion regarding Student A. Mr. Jewell made the second. There was a roll call vote. The motion passed with a vote of 4/1. Mr. Preece voted no.

Student A was to be expelled for 365 days. They could petition the Superintendent to return earlier. They would receive education virtually.

# b. Expulsion hearing of student B.

Mr. Jewell made the motion to go into executive session for the hearing of Student B. Mr. Kominar seconded that motion. The motion carried with a vote of 5/0. The time was12:16 p.m.

Mr. Jewell made the motion to return to regular session. Mr. Kominar seconded that motion. The motion carried with a vote of all ayes (5/0). The time was 12:25 p.m.

Mr. Slone announced the parent and student requested a continuance. Mr. Jewell made a motion to accept the continuance. Mr. Preece seconded that motion. The motion passed with a vote of 5/0.

Dr. Branch announced the meeting would continue at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, October 11, 2024.
