National Deans Competitive Scholarship	\$5,000/year (renewable up to four years)	2.85 unweighted high school GPA and 21 ACT composite	First-time, full-time students from West Virginia	Submit a completed admission application packet — including admission application form, transcripts and test scores — by the priority application deadline of March 15.
Eagle Tomorrow	\$10,000/year (renewable up to four years)	3.0 unweighted high school GPA and 21 ACT composite	First-time, full-time students from West Virginia	Submit a completed admission application packet — including admission application form, transcripts and test scores — by the priority application deadline of March 15.
Eagle Tomorrow - Add-on 1	\$500 per year (renewable up to four years)	3.50 unweighted high school GPA and 25 ACT composite	First-time, full-time students from West Virginia	Submit a completed admission application packet — including admission application form, transcripts and test scores — by the priority application deadline of March 15.

Alumni Scholarship	\$1,000/year (renewable) *Requires on campus housing for at least four semesters.	18 ACT composite and an Admission Indox of 500.	New incoming freshman who is a child, grandchild or spouse of an active MSU alumnus.	Submit a completed admissions application packet — including admission application, transcripts and test scores — by the priority application deadline of March 15.

Notes

The total duration of renewable scholarships is eight semesters, as long as the renewal criteria is met. Criteria for renewal will be listed in the official Award letter.

These scholarships require on campus housing for at least four semesters

College credit hours completed prior to high school graduation do not affect scholarship eligibility.

Awards based on academic criteria. Final GPA and official ACT scores affect awards

Total financial aid cannot exceed cost of attendance. Subsequent changes do not apply to the terms and conditions of an award.
