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Course Description:

Social and Emotional Learning:

impulses and motivating oneself to persevere in overcoming obstacles. They will also focus on making decisions based on different factors, including but not limited to, safety concerns and ethical standards.

Curriculum:

All subjects taught in the class are essential classes covering all basic information included in the West Virginia Standards for Language Arts, Math, Science, And Social Studies. The curriculum will be modified to meet each individual student's needs as presented in their Individual Education Plan (IEP). The material is presented using multiple modalities, with repetition and reinforcement, and allowing the students to grasp the material at their own academic level

GRADES:

Grades will be given based on completion of their daily assignments. All grades in the class are based on percentages. The completion of daily assignments and group work will contribute to the overall grade of the student.
