

gearing up for **Kindergarten**

Universal PK Transition and Kindergarten Registration

Mingo County Schools will hold Virtual Universal PK Transition and Kindergarten registration beginning May 10th –May 21st.

The first day of kindergarten is an important event in your child's life and your life as well. To make the transition to kindergarten as smooth as possible, Mingo County Schools will be providing videos that families can view with their student(s). Virtual tours of the kindergarten classroom, cafeteria, and bus, along with information from the nurse and a welcome by the principal will give you and your student a positive outlook for kindergarten.

Students currently enrolled in Head Start and PK will receive a Summer Reading Packet, that will include a Getting Ready for Kg workbook, along with books and additional kindergarten information. A checklist will be sent home with the student if additional documentation is needed, such as health or dental form.

Non-Program students, those who have not attended Head Start or PK, will be contacted about the pickup of the Summer Reading Packet and required documentation.

Links will be provided on the county and school website to assist families.

Families of students who will be entering kindergarten in the fall of 2021, will be able to access videos on each school's webpage beginning on May 10th.
